## Masahiro Ogawa 16th June 2017

We have a unique opportunity to hear a gifted and talented musician Masahiro Ogawa on June 16th. He has been living and working in London for the past three years and is soon going to return to Japan. He started playing the accordion at 5 years old taught by his mother who is a piano and accordion teacher. Since 12 years he has been self-taught and had type of further other formal He soon developed his own style of playing, particularly enjoying playing He has been a representative for Japan Accordion Promotion Conference (JAPC) whose aim it is the music of the accordion and to promote increasing the number of accordion players. Occasionally he organised a small group of ensembles such as duo with accordion, flute or violin for the performance at an annual concert of JAPC etc. He won the number one prize at the V-accordion contest organized by Roland in Japan in 2010 and he also played at the international V-Accordion contest in Rome in October 2010.

He was a contracted promoter of the electronic Roland accordion "Degisizer" from 1984 to 1986.

His major repertories by V-Accordion are; Thriller, Mission Impossible, Thunderbirds, Disney Medley, Classic Medley, Jon Williams Medley, 007 Theme Medley, Spain (C. Corea), Chameleon (H. Hancock), etc.

His favourite composers are Chick Corea, Richard Galliano, Herbie Hancock, . His performance will be very different to other accordionists repertoire.
